### THE SHOOT

Blackberries grow in abundance around our lovely field situated in Exbury in the New Forest, hence the name for this shoot. To make things a bit different, or difficult depending on your point of view, we've decided to make it a traditional 2-way Longbow shoot, but allowing Recurves & Barebows to sample the delights of a 2-way. After all, why should longbows have all the fun!! (No compounds - sorry, nothing personal, it's due to there being insufficient overshoot.)

### VENUE

Waterside Archers Field, near Exbury Gardens, Summer Lane, Exbury, Southampton SO45 1AZ  
Follow signs for Beaulieu National Motor Museum from Junc 2 of M27, then follow signs for Exbury Gardens at the Royal Oak Pub. The field is approx 2 miles from the pub, on the left hand side.

### ROUND

A traditional 2-way Western - 4 doz @ 60yds, 4 doz @50yds - shot in ends of 3 arrows. Straight in, no sighters, and no scopes. Open to all ages & bowstyles, (except compound - see above.)

### ENTRY FEES

£10-00 per archer

### EVENT TIMINGS

Registration 9-00am, Assembly 10-00 am.

### EVENT FORMAT

A 2-way Western round as above. Longbows:- Traditional longbow scoring will be used, i.e. winner will be the archer with most hits, second; highest score, third; most golds. Recurve & Barebow archers:- the usual scoring method will be used, highest score wins.

### SHOOTING RULES

This tournament will be shot to AGB rules in force at the time of the event.

### SMOKING

Would archers please note that smoking (including the use of e cigarettes) is only allowed in the carpark. Please do not leave cigarette butts on the ground. Entry to this event is considered acceptance of this policy.

### PHOTOGRAPHY & DRESS CODE
